The Rigamajig is a building kit designed for hands-on free play and learning.

Starting Out

With its collection of wooden planks, wheels, pulleys, nuts, bolts, and rope, the kit is designed to engage the mind and creative spirit of the child. The first thing to do is take all of the pieces out of the bag. Then, create a prompt for the child, or follow one of the prompts below. - •Build a Rigamajig that can lift something.
- •Build a Rigamajig you can get inside.
- •Build a contraption to take you to the center of the earth.
- •How many different ways can you join three pieces?
- •Build a contraption to send a bucket from one place to another.
- •Create something with four legs and a tail.
- •Give it a name. Make up a story about where it came from.

Remember Rigamajig has no right or wrong answers. The pieces are intuitive and fun to figure out. Allow your child to explore, play, and learn.
