Library Selects Firm for Building Project

The Washington-Centerville Public Library Board of Trustees announced recently that LWC Incorporated, the same firm that designed the master campus plan for Woodbourne Library, has been selected to implement the campus plan, as well as design and oversee the construction of the expansion and renovation of that same facility.

“The Library Board was impressed with LWC’s proposal and we have been pleased with the creativity and vision demonstrated in their design of the master campus plan. LWC also really took to heart the input from citizens and staff in creating the master plan, which was a critical priority for the Library Board,” said Bob Hanseman, President of the Library Board of Trustees.

After eight regional architectural firms submitted requests for proposals, a majority of the Library Trustees voted to hire LWC Inc. to complete the building project. “LWC brings a proven track record of creating dynamic public spaces to this project. LWC is the oldest architectural firm in the Dayton region. The firm is currently working on the Main Library project for the Dayton Metro Library and has been selected to design the system's new West Branch.
